



Symbiosis Exploration Guide

Read the book *How to Clean a Hippopotamus: A Look at Unusual Animal Partnerships* by Steve Jenkins and Robin Page. Search online for examples of symbiosis not covered in the book (animal–animal, animal–insect, or animal–human). Remember to look for reliable information from a credible source. Choose a symbiotic pair or group that interests you and complete these tasks:

1. Write at least one question (with answer) about your interdependent pair or group to be part of a compiled class worksheet on symbiosis. Your question may be in true/false, multiple choice, or fill-in-the-blank form. Identify the source of your information.
2. Use your research and art materials to make a collage about your pair or group, like those in the book, for a class-generated companion volume.
3. Give your question/answer and your illustrated page to your teacher.
