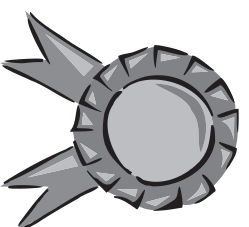


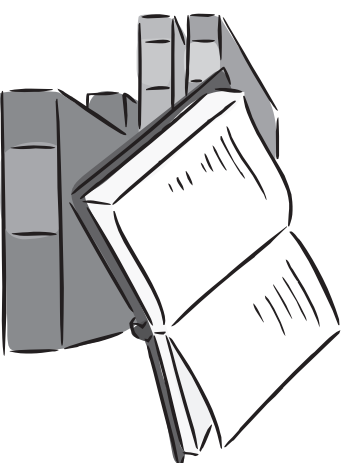
# Children's Literature Award Winners Match Game



Draw lines to match each book title in the middle column to its award-winning author or illustrator(s) in the other columns.

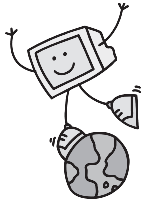

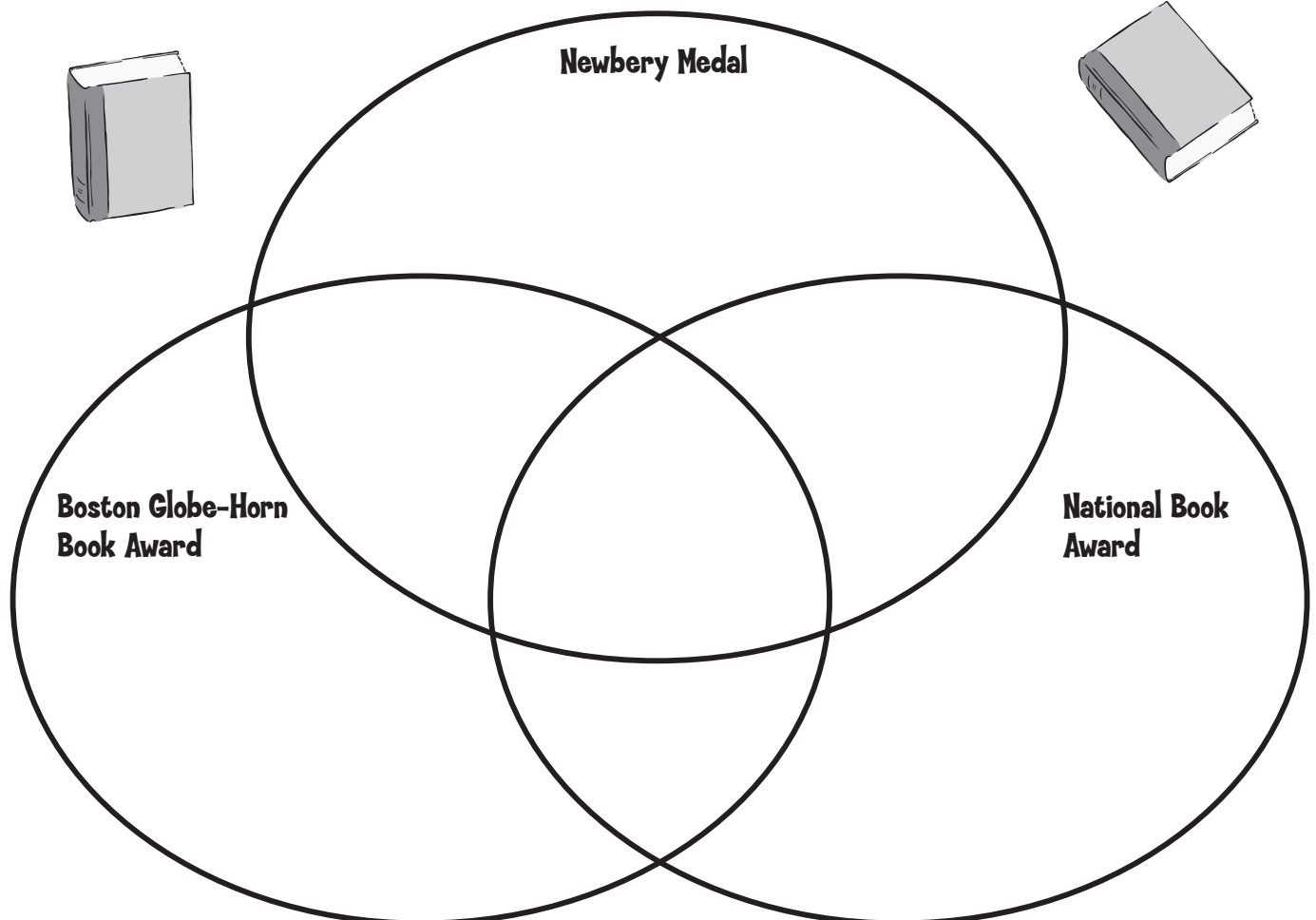
